GREEN LIGHT FOR BALLOT PN COAL QUEENSLAND

The Fair Work Commission late on Friday gave the go ahead for the Australian Electoral Commission to conduct a ballot of RTBU members covered by the PN Queensland Coal Agreement in respect to the potential industrial action in pursuit of a replacement Agreement.

Members want a fair go and deserve a fair go out of these negotiations. Even though the option to ballot members is now underway, the RTBU is more than willing to reconvene negotiations with PN in an effort to reach an Agreement that is likely to be acceptable to our members at any point. Such negotiations can occur regardless of whether or not a ballot is underway and does not compromise any result.

Things will move quickly now and we would like members to ensure your details are correct with the RTBU.
